The seminar will look at which energy statistics are available for the UK, where energy is consumed, and address how important transport energy use is in greater detail. Following on from a very interesting talk about aviation emissions last year we will have a short presentation on the often overlooked but vitally important area of shipping and its demand for energy, how statistics on shipping usage are collected and how the sector can be made greener. We also plan to have a short panel session at the end.

Energy Statistics

Warren Evans, Senior Energy Statistician, Department for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy (BEIS)

The Department for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy publishes an annual Digest of UK Energy Statistics (DUKES). Last summer, BEIS published the 70th edition of DUKES making it one of the longer running statistical publications in government. The presentation will trace changes in energy production and use over the last seventy years, with a focus on consumption for electricity generation and transport over the last ten years.

Energy Supply for Shipping

Tristan Smith, Reader in Energy and Shipping, Bartlett School Env, Energy & Resources, University College London

Shipping is a major user of energy and uses a similar amount to aviation. In the past high sulphur fuels have been used but a recent international agreement is reducing this. Tristan will talk about data for both energy supply for shipping and energy demand.

A panel discussion on energy statistics will follow the presentations.
