Whilst international passenger air transport has been dramatically reduced by covid air cargo has remained at 80 – 90% of the pre pandemic level. Most air cargo used to be carried in passenger aircraft so airlines have had to adapt in some cases converting passenger aircraft to all freight configuration. Cargo rates have in many cases increases so providing a financial lifeline for airlines.
